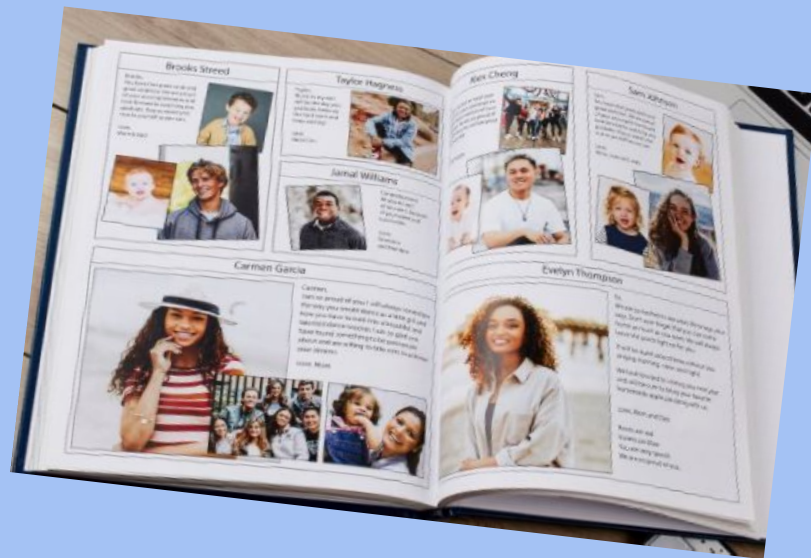
Yearbook is a great way to get involved with every aspect of SHS as it touches upon everything that goes on in our amazing school. :-)

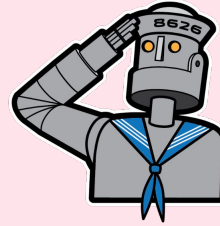

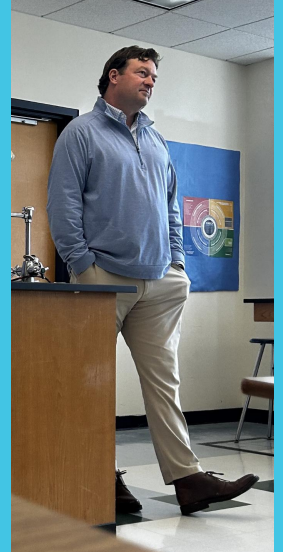

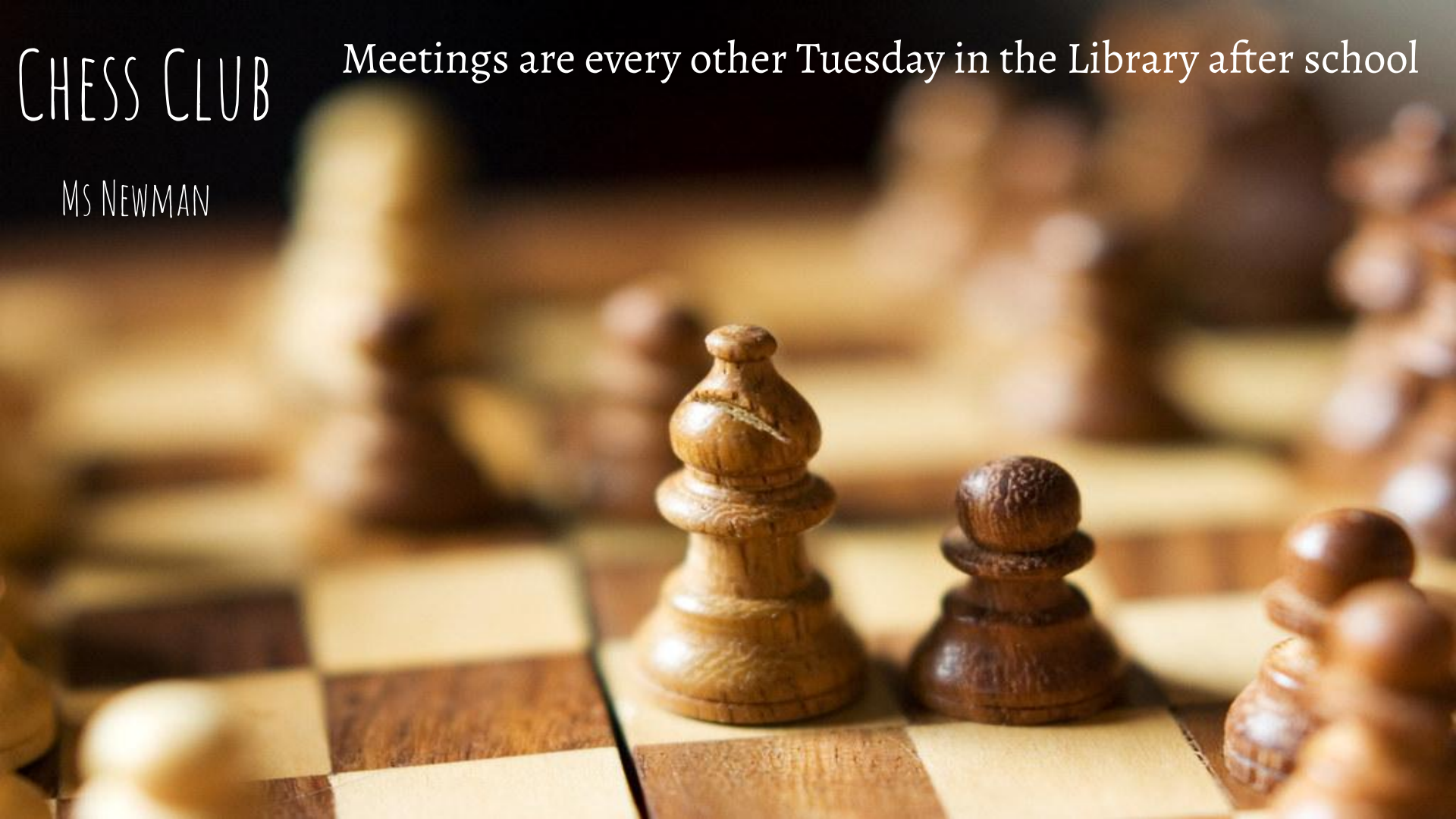
