Elective Choices for 10th Grade:

- Please note: A yearlong course is 4 credits. A half-year/semester course is 2 credits. PE and Health courses are 1 credit each.
- In addition to required courses, students will need 6 additional credits to create a full schedule.
- Students who require Academic Strategies must select Academic Strategies #047 (2 credits) and #048 (2 credits).
- When entering final choices into Aspen, students will also be asked to enter Electives as well as 3 Alternates in case some courses reach capacity.
- Four (4) credits of Fine and Performing Arts coursework are required for students to graduate from SHS. These credits can be taken during any year.
